




Freestanding guardrail



PRODUCT DEFINITION

The EVO® freestanding guardrail is a collective fall protection system designed to protect roof terraces not accessible to the public, when it is technically impossible to fix it either to the parapet or to the concrete slab. It avoids any drilling in the roof, thus preserving the waterproofing. Their design allows for quick and easy installation thanks to the rails that simply plug into each other with their shrunken ends.


REGULATION

The EVO® freestanding guardrail complies with the standard EN ISO 14122-3 of March 2017, machines safety - permanent access means to machines – part 3: staircases, step ladders, guardrails – Permanent means of access.

The EVO® freestanding guardrail passed with success the static and dynamic tests required by the standards EN ISO 14122-3.

STANDARDS

- A guardrail must be installed as soon as the possible height of fall is higher than 500 mm.
- The guardrail handrail height must be comprising between 1000 and 1100 mm above the walking area.
- The distance between the handrail and kneerail, as well as between the kneerail and the toeboard must be less than or equal to 500 mm.
- A toeboard of 100 mm height minimum must be installed at 12 mm maximum from the walking area and the side of the platform.
- 3 counterweights must be installed (37.5 kg) on each support leg located at the end, for every section ending with a plug.
- The implementation of EVO® freestanding guardrail necessarily implies the existence of a parapet wall on the terrace roof, to avoid any risk of tipping over; Otherwise, contact our design office.
- If the handrail is interrupted, the free space between two segments of the handrail should be between 75 mm and 120 mm. If there is a larger opening, a gate to ensure the continuity of the fall protection of the guardrail must be installed.
- Freestanding guardrail must not be installed on a slope greater than 15°.




NF: French standard NF E85-015 / EN: European Standard EN ISO 14122-3

- Foldable: A lifeline must be installed before the foldable guardrail is mounted. This will also be used during installation and handling.

INSTALLATION AND WIND ZONES

The EVO® freestanding guardrail (2 counterweights on each support leg and 3 counterweights per support leg at the ends) is compatible with wind zone 1 (protected, normal and exposed site), zone 2 (protected and normal site) and zone 3 (protected and normal site), that is to say, by way of indication, a maximum speed of 166 km/h*. Any other configuration requires special precautions (addition of counterweights) that must be previously studied and validated by our design office. The responsibility of Delta Plus Systems can not be committed for any installation not respecting these recommendations.








UNIQUE COUNTERWEIGHTS

In order to prevent musculoskeletal disorders, our R&D department has designed a unique counterweight on the market with a lighter weight of 12.5 kg.

Ergonomically designed, it comes with two handles that make it easy to hold while taking care of the user's spine.

The load is thus divided by two, making it easier to use and grip.

The centre of gravity is also located as close as possible to the operator's body.


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Maximum distance between uprights: 1500 mm
- Installation with self-drilling screws supplied
- 20 mm parapet or abutment required for any installation of the EVO® self-supporting guardrail
- Before installing a freestanding guardrail, it is essential to check the capacity of the waterproofing complex to withstand contact pressure. In the case of the EVO freestanding guardrail, the contact pressure is 0.026 DaN / Cm².
- Mandatory toeboard if parapet ≤ 100 mm
- Maximum slope of 15° / 27%.

USE & MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS

- Before use, please refer to the technical instructions supplied with the product and available on request
- Aluminium product storage: it is important to store the packages in a sheltered and dry place
- Before installing folding guardrails, the installation of a Delta Plus Systems lifeline is mandatory to secure the workers
- It is prohibited to use handles to lift the counterweights on the roof.

- The person performing the installation of EVO® guardrail must be a qualified person and must observe the common rules on working at heights. It must thus ensure his own security (use of a temporary lifeline, PPE, aerial lift, etc)
- Before any use, user must ensure by visual inspection that EVO® guardrail shows no anomaly (shock, distortion, etc.)


- The EVO® guardrail does not require any particular maintenance, however, a visual inspection must be carried out at least once a year by a qualified person
- If the guardrail EVO® is improperly installed, damaged or has been used
 to arrest a fall, its use must be stopped immediately and it must not be
 used until a qualified person has authorized in writing its reuse after examination and verification
- If the product is sold outside the first country of destination, it is essential for the safety of the user that the reseller provides the instructions of use in the language of the country of the product use. These documents can be provided upon request by contacting the manufacturer
- EVO® guardrail is a mean of permanent collective protection which must be used by professionals on flat roofs not accessible to the public
- The use of a EVO® toeboard is madatory if the terrace does not have any parapet or if it is less than 100 mm height.
- If EVO® guardrail is installed in a polluted industrial environment, petrochemical, maritime or on seaside, it is compulsory to make a surface treatment appropriated type powder coating, anodizing, etc.

STORAGE

Raw aluminum components are packaged in contact with each other. The action of the rain on the unopened package will facilitate the oxidation of these components. Surface stains may occur. They do not degrade the quality of aluminum but can spoil the appearance of the railings.

We recommend you to unpack the package and to store the components separated from each other (no contact between them), or to store the packages still packed in a dry place.





Installation of straight freestanding guardrail - External angle Installation of straight freestanding guardrail - Internal angle









INSTALLATION

The installation of the EVO® guardrail must be done by a minimum of two people. It is recommended to start installation in an angle.



1 - Draw a mark each 1500 mm as a maximum and take out the gravel if necessary in order to set up the guardrail.



2 - Place the plastic counterweights on the support legs. The tube of the support leg
must be flush with the surface of the plastic counterweight.
(The 3rd counterweight is installed outside the leg)









3 - Insert a middlerail through 2 uprights


4 - Insert the set into the fixing supports and add the locking pins




5 - Put the rail on the uprights




9 - Clip EZclip to the top of the upright



7 - Tighten self-drilling screws 4,8 x 25 on upright, where rail and middlerail are positioned




8 - Once the guardrail is mounted, tighten the selfdrilling screws 4.8 x 50 as stated above.



9 - Plug together rails and middlerails 10 - Clip rail and middleand fix them with 4,8x16 screws.





12 - Adjust last section by sawing swagged extra



13 - Clip caps and wall brackets to rails and middlerails






INSTALLATION: WALL BRACKETS




1 - Fix wall brackets using self-drilling 4.8 x 25 screws


INSTALLATION: TOEBOARD



1 - Place the toeboard support on the base and secure it with 4 self-drilling screws TH 4.8 x 16 (2 screws on each side)



2 - Attach the toeboard lengths between them through the toeboard connectors and 4 selfdrilling screws TH 4.8 x 16



3 - For angles, secure the inner and external connectors with 8 self-drilling screws TH 4.8 x 16



4 - Finally, fix the toeboard plugs with one self-drilling screw TH 4.8 x 16
